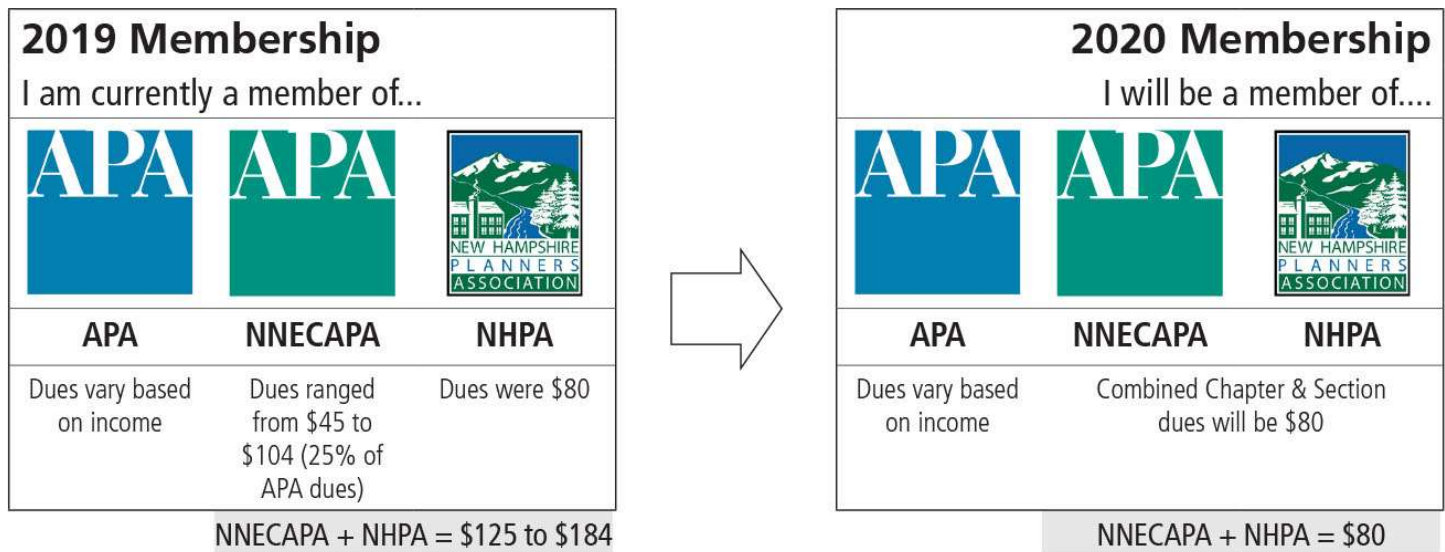
Re: Changes to your NNECAPA and NHPA membership renewal process for 2020

The New Hampshire Planners Association (NHPA) is becoming a Section of the Northern New England Chapter of the American Planning Association (NNECAPA). Here is what to expect about how your dues amount and method of payment will change.


**Member of APA/NNECAPA & NHPA**

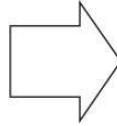
When your APA/NNECAPA renewal comes due in 2020, your Chapter dues will be \$80 and will automatically include your NHPA membership. You will not need to renew your NHPA membership separately or pay additional dues. If you were previously an NHPA member through an organizational membership, discuss this with your employer, as you will no longer need to pay NHPA dues separately. During the 2020-2021 transition period, annual Chapter dues will be \$80. NNECAPA anticipates returning to a dues system based on a percentage of APA dues (which are income-based) in 2022.



**Individual member of NHPA Only**

All members of NHPA who renew their membership for 2020 will become members of both the Chapter (NNECAPA) and the New Hampshire Section (NHPA). Later this fall, you will receive an email from the American Planning Association (APA) asking you to renew your Chapter membership (APA manages membership on behalf of NNECAPA) for a period beginning January 2020. You will not need to become a member of the APA to be a member of NNECAPA and NHPA. Your NNECAPA dues for 2020 will be \$80 and will automatically include your NHPA membership. You will not need to renew your NHPA membership separately or pay additional dues.

### Organizational Members of NHPA Only

All members of NHPA who renew their membership for 2020 will become members of both the Chapter (NNECAPA) and the New Hampshire Section (NHPA). Later this year, your organization will receive membership renewal forms from NNECAPA. A form will need to be completed for each person in your organization that is an NHPA member. The NNECAPA dues for 2020 will be \$280 for your organization and will automatically include both NNECAPA and NHPA membership. You will not need to renew your NHPA organizational membership separately or pay additional dues.

NNECAPA will be continuing to offer organizational membership during the 2020-2021 transition period for those organizations that were previously NHPA members. Starting in 2022, organizational membership will be phased out and those people in your organization who want to continue being NNECAPA and NHPA members will need to join as individuals.
